We are looking forward to a great Summer at Reeds Community Swim Club! And we look forward to having you back! Please note the following important updates regarding the 2013 Swim Season:

- ❖ **Membership Packages:** This season we are continuing membership packages for Family and Single Parent Family/Couple/Single for current members only. **There will be 2 Membership packages available:**

Family - \$350.00

Single Parent Family/Couple/Single - \$300.00

Incentive: Members will be given a \$25.00 DISCOUNT if their dues are post marked by April 30th.

Deadline: Anyone who wishes to join the pool after June 1 will incur a \$50 Late Fee

- ❖ **New Memberships - \$300.00 Plus Stock fee of \$50 for total of \$350.00. This New rate applies to all family types and Individuals.**

- ❖ **Baby Sitter Membership Fee - \$50.00**

- ❖ **Stock:** 2013 Stock prices for NEW Members are being reduced from previous years to \$50.00. Stock fees are paid in addition to the price of Membership Packages.

- ❖ **Payment Method Changes & Incentives:** Reeds Community Swim Club will accept check or money order **ONLY** for payment of membership dues. The purpose of this is to eliminate excessive cash on site during opening week. There are great start-up costs prior to the pool opening. Prompt collection of dues will assure these expenses are covered & prevent delays for opening day. To assist in the prompt receipt of membership dues, we will offer further incentive to those who pay the 2013 membership dues early. **Any member who pays the membership dues by April 30, 2013 will receive a \$25.00 discount.**

Job Opportunities: The board is currently accepting applications for several staff positions. If you would like to submit an application, please go to our website, call or email the pool at 336-787-5010 (after 5/1) or by email at reedscommunitypool@gmail.com for more information. Returning managers, lifeguards and Swim Team Coach are given first consideration for the positions available. Managers must be certified for pool management and be able to provide proof of completion of the Certified Pool Operator (CPO) course and CPR/First Aid certifications. The manager is required to have their Lifeguard Certification in addition to CPO and CPR certifications. Other requirements for managers include the ability to supervise and communicate effectively, yet respectfully with staff and pool members. **Applications for the Manager are due no later than April 15th.**

❖ **Committees:** The following committees have been established in order to aid in the function of the swim club. Each committee will have a chairperson who will lead, coordinate volunteers, plan, and assist in pool functions and operations.

❖ **Swim-Team Opportunities:** The Reeds Swim Team, Reeds Aqua-Dragons, offers great learning, fun, and exercise to children. Swim Team Fees for members are \$15.00/child and \$30.00/two children or more. Swim Team Pass is \$75.00 per child, plus the \$25.00 swim camp. Sign-ups will be held the first weekend the pool is open. You can join when you pay your dues or wait and see if the Aqua Dragons are right for you. Practices will start shortly after the pool opens May 25th and the first meet is usually mid-June. 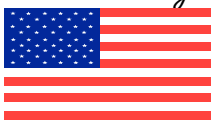
