Dear Pool Member,

We are looking forward to a great summer at Reeds Community Swim Club. Please note the following important updates regarding the 2011 Swim Season:

- ❖ **Membership Packages:** This season we are continuing membership packages for Family and Single Parent Family/Couple/Single. **There will be 2 Membership packages available:**
  - Family - \$300.00 (includes 5 visitor passes if paid by May 7<sup>th</sup>)**
  - Single Parent Family/Couple/Single - \$250.00 (includes 3 visitor passes if paid by May 7<sup>th</sup>)****At this time there will be an assessment fee of \$75 with the goal to address maintenance issues that have been a necessity to meet State standards.** We will also continue as last year with a **2011 Membership Drive** to recruit new members with money saving incentives for current members of the club. For every new member application you submit that results in the approval of a new member, we will issue you a \$50.00 incentive check. You can go to our website and print applications as needed. Please be sure to include your name as the sponsor to assure you receive your incentive payment. Each new application will be reviewed and go through the approval process by the board of directors as adopted in prior seasons. Incentive checks will be issued the first of each month beginning June 1, 2011.
- ❖ **Stock:** **Stock prices will increase to \$100 per share.** All new members will pay this in addition to the price of their Membership Package. Stocks are limited and provided on a first come basis at these prices. We are striving to be full capacity in the future.
- ❖ **Payment Method Changes & Incentives:** Reeds Community Swim Club will accept check or money order **only** for payment of membership dues. The purpose of this is to eliminate excessive cash on site during opening week. There are great start-up costs prior to the pool opening. Prompt collection of dues will assure these expenses are covered & prevent delays for opening day. To assist in the prompt receipt of membership dues, we will offer further incentive to members who pay the 2011 membership dues early. **Any member who pays the membership dues by May 7, 2011 will be issued visitors passes (see above) on opening that can be used any day of the week.** These passes are non-transferrable, must be used with an active member and will be valid for one (1) visitor per pass during the 2011 season. Please send your check or money order made payable to **Reeds Community Swim Club, P.O. Box 2104, Lexington NC 27293-2104.**
- ❖ **Upcoming Dates:** Please mark your calendars for the following important dates:
  - **"Clean-up Days":** Saturday, May 7, May 14, and May 21<sup>st</sup> from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. All members are strongly encouraged to come out & help ready the pool for the upcoming season. Some useful tools and supplies to bring would be rakes, shovels, donated flowers and soil, work gloves, paint brushes, household cleaners, paper towels or anything you think can help ready the pool for opening day.
  - **Opening Day:** May 28, 2010- Memorial Day weekend
  - **Opening weekend Pool Hours:**
    - Saturday, May 28<sup>rd</sup>            11:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
    - Sunday, May 29<sup>th</sup>            1:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.
    - Monday, May 30<sup>th</sup>            11:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.
- ❖ **2011 Pool Hours:**
  - Please note that in order to serve you better the board has decided that the pool will be closed every Tuesday to serve as a maintenance day and also for Swim Meets.
  - Also note that the pool will open earlier on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. This change will allow patrons to use the pool for a longer duration on these days.

**The pool will not be open while school is in session with the following exceptions:**

**Open on Fridays from 5-9pm: June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> (4pm -11 pm), August 26<sup>th</sup>, September 2<sup>nd</sup> and Saturdays from 11-7 and Sundays from 1-7.**

**Therefore, the pool will be closed the following days during school:**

May 31<sup>st</sup>, June 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup>, August 25<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup>, September 1<sup>st</sup>,

- ❖ **Visitor Days:** Guests may visit the pool on Wednesdays or Saturdays for \$6.00 / person. Children two (2) years of age & under - \$3.00. Out of town guests (outside Davidson County) may visit anytime.
- ❖ **Voice-mail:** In an effort to answer your questions promptly & efficiently, we have two methods of contacting the Board of Directors. Please call the pool at 336-787-5010 and leave a message with any questions or concerns and a board member will return your call promptly. - ❖ **Job Opportunities:** The board is currently accepting applications for several staff positions. The pool will operate under the supervision of **one manager** this season. Returning managers, lifeguards and Swim Team Coach are given first consideration for the positions available. Managers must be certified for pool management and be able to provide proof of completion of the Certified Pool Operator (CPO) course and CPR/First Aid certifications. Other requirements for managers include the ability to supervise and communicate effectively with staff and pool members
- ❖ **Committees:** The following committees have been established in order to aid in the function of the swim club. Each committee will have a chairperson who will lead, coordinate volunteers, plan, and assist in pool functions and operations.

- ❖ **Swim-Team Opportunities:** The Reeds Swim Team, Reeds Aqua-Dragons, offers great learning, fun, and exercise to children. Swim Team Fees are \$15.00/child and \$30.00/two children or more. Sign-ups will be held the first weekend the pool is open. You can join when you pay your dues or wait and see if it is something you're interested in being a part of. Practices will start shortly after the pool opens May 28 and the first meet is usually mid-June. For more information on Swim Team opportunities, please check out the website or ask at the guard stand.
- ❖ **Private Party:** Reeds Community Swim Club can be rented for private parties on Saturday and Sunday evenings for a two (2) hour time slot. The cost is \$150.00 for members and \$200.00 for non-members. Please check the website or see a pool manager for availability.
- ❖ **Fun-Days:** Each Summer we try to incorporate special events to bring families together for poolside fun. Past events have included School's Out Party, Movie Nights and 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration. To make these types of events happen and be successful we need member involvement to lead and serve on the Events/Fundraising Committee.
